When Cierra lay down on her new apartment's soft, clean carpet, she exhaled in gratitude. She was so grateful that this was **her** place, a new chapter in her family's story. Weeks prior, Cierra left an abusive relationship and began working with local agencies to get her family's life back on track. One of her case managers reached out to Bridge of Hope, knowing our program would support Cierra's family's long-term success. A lot of calls, socially distanced meetings, taxi rides, nights in a hotel, job applications and childcare arrangements later, Cierra got a job and an apartment within the same week! A small group of Neighboring Volunteers is being trained to walk with Cierra's family during the program. Soon there will be a Neighborhood Launch followed by a House Blessing, and Cierra will be in the rhythm of regular case management sessions to help her reach the goals she has set for her family. They will not be alone on this journey. They will be safe and supported.

Cierra's apartment has large windows that bring in lots of sunlight, and that feels symbolic of the hope that is pouring in on her and her family at this moment.
